The Township of Hartford hereby resolves, according to the provisions of MCL211.30 (7) of the General Property Act, that the board of review shall receive letters of protest regarding assessments from resident taxpayers from the first Tuesday in March until it adjourns hearings for which it meets to hear such protests.

All notices of assessment change and all advertisements of board of review meetings are to include a statement that resident taxpayers may protest by letter to the board.
