Chairperson Sefcik called to order a Regular Meeting of the Hartford Township Planning Commission on June 26, 2007 at 7:30 P.M.

Roll Call: Getz, Dowd, Meachum, Moody and Sefcik.

Also Present: Zoning Administrator Lechenet and a township resident.

Absent: Banic (unapproved) and Soden (unapproved).

Dowd moved to approve the minutes of the May 22, 2007 regular meeting of the Hartford Township Planning Commission as corrected, seconded by Getz. Motion carried.

Meachum moved to approve the agenda, seconded by Dowd. Motion carried.

Dowd reported that the representatives from the city and township have begun meetings to discuss updating the Hartford Community Master Use Plan.

Lechenet reported on several properties that had zoning issues and on properties that were being cleaned up. Lechenet also reported that a possible site condominium was being planned for 61st street.

Discussion took place concerning fences and swimming pools in the township. Concerns were raised over who is responsible for "governing" them (i.e., the township, state or building inspector).

Lechenet handed out copies of the current Community Master Plan for each PC member to read before the next meeting.

Dowd moved to adjourn, seconded by Meachum. Motion carried.
